Dear Prospective Paramedic Student,

Thank you for your interest in our EMS program! Our next EMT-Paramedic Program will begin on February 25, 2010. Class will be held each *Monday and Thursday* from 0900 to 1700 hours at CJCFPD Station #3 in Blue Springs, MO. Several weekend sessions are scheduled to accommodate certification programs.

Our program is instructed by a variety of prehospital providers, nurses and physicians with many years of clinical experience and expertise. Our curriculum exceeds the requirements of the DOT, MO Bureau of EMS and the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians.

Course tuition is \$4500.00, which is all inclusive of required program expenses. Initial deposit to guarantee your position in this class is \$500.00. An additional \$1000.00 is due the first evening of class. A scheduled payment plan can be arranged.

You may return your application and deposit Monday through Friday from 8:00-5:00 at CJCFPD Station #3, at 805 NE Jefferson, Blue Springs, MO (approximately I70 & Adams Dairy Parkway). **Other required documents must be submitted by the first day of class.** Class size is limited and will be filled as qualified applicants are received. ***Applications must be received no later than February 01, 2010.***

All applicants to the Central Jackson County Fire Protection District's EMT-Paramedic Program must meet the following criteria to be considered for program acceptance.

- Complete program application.
- Provide copy of high school diploma or GED certificate.
- Provide a copy of current Missouri license or National Registry Certification.
- Complete felony statement on program application.
- Provide two letters of recommendation from persons currently in the medical field.
- Submit a two-page typed essay on why candidate is pursuing EMT-P as a career and why he/she should be accepted to this program.
- Complete an entrance exam and interview.
- *Prefer* one-year college level study in basic math & English as well as introductory anatomy & physiology.

Applicants are encouraged to submit applications as soon as completed. Other required documents may be submitted on the first class session.

We accept Visa/Master Charge Payments.

If applicant withdraws prior to first class date, a non-refundable application processing fee of \$100.00 will be deducted from the deposit.
